## Overview

This 6-day Great Migration safari is designed for American travelers who want to experience Tanzania during the Ndutu calving season, one of the most rewarding times for wildlife viewing in East Africa. From late January through March, the southern Serengeti and Ndutu plains attract massive herds of wildebeest and zebra as thousands of calves are born. This creates one of the best safari experiences for seeing the Great Migration together with predators such as lions, cheetahs, and hyenas. Operated by Travel Hype Adventures, this Tanzania Great Migration safari combines focused game drives in the Ndutu area with a visit to the Ngorongoro Conservation Area for a well-rounded northern Tanzania safari in comfort.

## Day 1

### Arrival in Arusha

Meals: Dinner | Accommodation: Arusha hotel or lodge

Arrive at Kilimanjaro International Airport, where you are met and transferred to Arusha. This is your arrival day to rest after your international flight from the United States and prepare for your Great Migration safari. Depending on arrival time, enjoy a relaxed evening and a short safari briefing from Travel Hype Adventures.

## Day 2

### Arusha to Ndotu

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Ndotu camp or lodge

After breakfast, depart Arusha and drive toward the Ngorongoro Highlands and into the Ndotu region, one of the best areas for a Great Migration safari in calving season. The drive is long but scenic, with changing landscapes from highlands to open grasslands. Arrive in time for an afternoon game drive if schedule allows, with your first chance to see wildebeest herds, zebra, and predators across the Ndotu plains.

## Day 3

### Full Day Game Drive in Ndotu

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Ndotu camp or lodge

Spend a full day exploring Ndotu and the surrounding southern Serengeti ecosystem. This is the heart of the calving season and one of the top times to book a Great Migration safari in Tanzania. You may see newborn wildebeest, large mixed herds, and predators following the movement of prey. Your guide will track the best wildlife areas based on the latest animal activity and road conditions.

## Ndotu to Ngorongoro Conservation Area

### Day 5

### **What is the best time for a Great Migration safari in Ndutu?**
