Day 1

Arrival in Nairobi, Kenya

After breakfast, depart Nairobi and travel to the Masai Mara National Reserve. The Mara is one of Kenya's best-known safari destinations and an essential part of a classic Kenya and Tanzania safari. After arrival, enjoy your first game drive as you look for lions, elephants, giraffes, zebras, buffalo, and many other animals across the rolling plains.

Serengeti Game Drive and Transfer to Ngorongoro Highlands

Karatu to Tarangire National Park

Travel to Tarangire National Park, a destination known for giant baobab trees, large elephant herds, and rich river-based wildlife. Game drives in Tarangire often produce sightings of elephants, giraffes, zebras, wildebeest, buffalo, lions, and many bird species. The landscapes here offer a different feel from both the Masai Mara and Serengeti, which makes the overall Kenya and Tanzania safari more varied and rewarding.
