Itinerary

Day 1

Arrival in Tanzania and Transfer to Arusha

Meals: Dinner | Accommodation: Arusha lodge or hotel

Day 2

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Tarangire lodge or tented camp

After breakfast, drive to Tarangire National Park for your first full safari experience. Tarangire is known for large elephant herds, ancient baobab trees, open savannah, riverine habitats, and rewarding wildlife viewing. The park is an excellent introduction to Tanzania for UK travellers because it offers classic safari scenery and strong chances of seeing elephants, giraffes, zebras, wildebeest, antelopes, and a wide range of birdlife.

Day 3

Leave Tarangire and travel towards Serengeti National Park, passing through the Ngorongoro highlands and scenic rural landscapes. The drive forms part of the safari experience, with changing views as you move from highland areas into the wider Serengeti ecosystem. Arrive in the Serengeti for an afternoon game drive, giving you your first opportunity to experience one of Africa's most famous wildlife destinations.

Day 4

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Serengeti lodge or tented camp

Spend a full day exploring Serengeti National Park with your private guide. The Serengeti is the centrepiece of this 1 week Tanzania safari, offering open plains, kopjes, river areas, and excellent wildlife viewing. Depending on the season and location, you may see lions, cheetahs, leopards, elephants, buffalo, giraffes, hyenas, zebras, wildebeest, gazelles, and many other species. Your guide will plan the day around wildlife movement, light, road conditions, and your interests.

Day 5

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Ngorongoro or Karatu lodge

Enjoy a final morning game drive in the Serengeti before travelling towards the Ngorongoro area. This day gives you another chance to look for wildlife before leaving the plains and moving into the highlands. The route is scenic and varied, helping British tourists experience more of northern Tanzania's landscapes within a compact 7-day itinerary.

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Day 6 **Ngorongoro Crater Safari and Return to Arusha**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Arusha lodge or hotel

After an early breakfast, descend into the Ngorongoro Crater for a memorable game drive in one of Tanzania's most celebrated wildlife areas. The crater floor offers a compact but rich safari environment, with opportunities to see lions, buffalo, elephants, hippos, zebras, wildebeest, and many other animals. After the crater experience, drive back towards Arusha for your final night in Tanzania.
