Overview

This 10 day Great Migration Safari is created for British tourists who want a well-paced Tanzania safari focused on the Serengeti wildebeest migration without missing the wider highlights of northern Tanzania. The journey begins in Arusha, continues to Tarangire for elephant-rich landscapes, explores the Ngorongoro Crater, and then moves into the Serengeti for several days of migration-focused game viewing. Because the Great Migration moves throughout the year, the exact Serengeti location can be adjusted according to your travel month, using areas such as Ndutu and the Southern Serengeti during the calving season, the Central or Western Serengeti during movement periods, and the Northern Serengeti during the river-crossing season. This Great Migration Safari is ideal for UK travellers who want strong wildlife viewing, expert local guiding, comfortable accommodation, and a route designed around the best possible migration conditions at the time of travel.

Itinerary

Day 1

Arrival in Arusha

Meals: Dinner | Accommodation: Arusha lodge

Arrive at Kilimanjaro International Airport and meet the Travel Hype Adventures team for your transfer to Arusha. After check-in, relax at your lodge and receive a short safari briefing covering the route, migration expectations, luggage guidance, and practical details for British travellers arriving in Tanzania.

Arusha to Tarangire National Park

Day 2

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Tarangire lodge or tented camp

Travel to Tarangire National Park for your first full safari experience. Tarangire is known for large elephant herds, baobab trees, riverine habitats, and strong dry-season wildlife concentrations. This is a rewarding opening day before the journey continues towards the Serengeti migration areas.

Day 3 **Tarangire to the Ngorongoro Highlands**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Ngorongoro or Karatu lodge

Enjoy a final morning in the Tarangire area before travelling towards the Ngorongoro Highlands. The route offers changing scenery, local village landscapes, and views across the Rift Valley region. Arrive near Karatu or the crater rim area in time to rest before the Ngorongoro Crater experience the following day.

Day 4 **Ngorongoro Crater Safari**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Ngorongoro or Karatu lodge

Descend into the Ngorongoro Crater for a full wildlife-viewing experience in one of Africa's most famous natural settings. The crater floor offers excellent chances to see lions, buffalo, zebras, wildebeest, hyenas, hippos, and many other species in a compact area. After the game drive, continue back to your lodge in the highlands.

Ngorongoro to Central Serengeti

Day 5

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Central Serengeti lodge or tented camp

Travel towards Serengeti National Park, entering one of the world's most celebrated wildlife landscapes. The Central Serengeti is productive throughout the year and is especially strong for big cats, open plains, kopjes, and classic safari scenery. This day introduces the Serengeti section of your Great Migration Safari with an afternoon game drive en route to camp.

Central Serengeti to the Seasonal Migration Area

Day 6

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Seasonal Serengeti migration camp

Continue through the Serengeti towards the seasonal migration area selected for your travel month. Depending on the time of year, this may be Ndotu and the Southern Serengeti, the Western

Serengeti, the Central Serengeti, or the Northern Serengeti. The aim is to place your safari as close as practical to the moving wildebeest and zebra herds.

Full Day Great Migration Safari in Serengeti

Day 7

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Seasonal Serengeti migration camp

Spend a full day tracking the Great Migration with your guide. The day is planned around current wildlife movement, road conditions, and the best viewing opportunities available in the selected Serengeti region. You may see vast wildebeest and zebra herds, predators following the migration, and the wider Serengeti ecosystem at its most dramatic.

Second Full Day in the Migration Area

Day 8

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Seasonal Serengeti migration camp

Enjoy another full day in the seasonal migration zone. Having more than one day in the same area improves your chance of strong sightings because the migration is a natural movement rather than a fixed event. Your guide will adjust the plan to focus on herd locations, predator activity, photography opportunities, and the best available wildlife action.

Serengeti to Arusha

Day 9

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Arusha lodge

After breakfast, enjoy a final Serengeti game drive before travelling to the nearest airstrip for a scheduled flight to Arusha, or return by road depending on the final routing and quotation. On arrival in Arusha, transfer to your lodge for a relaxed final evening in Tanzania.

FAQs

When is the best time for a Great Migration Safari in Tanzania?

The Great Migration is a year-round movement, but the best Serengeti area depends on the month of travel. Ndutu and the Southern Serengeti are often used during the calving season, while the Western, Central, and Northern Serengeti can be better at other times of the year.

Is this Great Migration Safari suitable for British tourists?

Yes. The itinerary is written for British tourists and UK travellers, with clear logistics, private guiding, comfortable safari accommodation, and a pace that works well for guests flying long-haul to Tanzania.

Does this package guarantee a river crossing?

No safari can guarantee a river crossing because migration behaviour depends on rainfall, herd movement, and natural conditions. The itinerary is designed to place you in the best available migration region for your travel period.

Why does the itinerary include Tarangire and Ngorongoro before Serengeti?

Tarangire and Ngorongoro add major wildlife variety before the Serengeti migration section. They help make the safari more complete by combining elephant country, crater wildlife, and several days focused on the Great Migration.

Can this 10 day Great Migration Safari be customised?

Yes. The route, accommodation level, domestic flights, and Serengeti migration area can be customised based on your travel month, budget, comfort preference, and arrival or departure flights from the UK.
