Tarangire introduces you to elephant herds, baobab scenery, and varied savannah habitats; the Serengeti offers wide open plains and classic big cat country; and Ngorongoro provides one of the most concentrated wildlife viewing experiences in East Africa. Day 2**Arusha to Tarangire National Park**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Tarangire or Karatu lodge

After breakfast, drive to Tarangire National Park for your first full wildlife experience. Tarangire is known for large elephant herds, baobab trees, open grassland, riverine habitats, and rewarding game viewing. Enjoy a game drive with picnic lunch in the park before continuing to your lodge or camp for dinner and overnight.

Tarangire Area to Serengeti National Park**Day 3**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Serengeti lodge or tented camp

Travel towards Serengeti National Park, passing through the Ngorongoro highlands and scenic rural landscapes. On arrival in the Serengeti, begin your game drive across one of Africa's most famous safari destinations. The Serengeti is excellent for big cats, grazing herds, wide plains, and classic safari photography, making it a major highlight of this 5 days safari for British travellers.

Serengeti Game Drive and Transfer to Ngorongoro Area**Day 4**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Ngorongoro or Karatu lodge

Start the day with a morning game drive in the Serengeti when wildlife is often active and the light is ideal for photography. Continue exploring the plains in search of lions, cheetahs, leopards, elephants, giraffes, zebras, wildebeest, and other wildlife. Later, travel towards the Ngorongoro area for dinner and overnight, positioning you well for the crater experience the next day.

Ngorongoro Crater Safari and Return to Arusha**Day 5**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

After breakfast, descend into the Ngorongoro Crater for a memorable game drive in one of Tanzania's most remarkable wildlife areas. The crater floor supports a dense concentration of animals, including lions, buffalo, zebras, wildebeest, hyenas, hippos, and a wide range of birdlife. After lunch, drive back to Arusha for your onward arrangements. This completes a compact but rich 5 days safari across Northern Tanzania.
