This 2 week Tanzania safari is designed for British travellers who want more than a short highlights trip. Over 14 days, the itinerary follows a carefully paced Northern Tanzania route through Tarangire, Lake Manyara, Serengeti National Park, the Ngorongoro Conservation Area, Lake Eyasi, and Arusha. The journey gives meaningful time for game drives, scenic travel, cultural encounters, and relaxed transitions between destinations, making it a strong choice for couples, families, and wildlife lovers planning a once-in-a-lifetime Tanzania holiday. The route places extra emphasis on the Serengeti and Ngorongoro, while still including Tarangire's elephant country, Lake Manyara's forest and lake landscapes, and the cultural setting around Lake Eyasi. Travel Hype Adventures operates this private safari with British English-speaking guests in mind, offering clear logistics, comfortable accommodation options, and a professional safari flow from arrival to departure.

Itinerary

Day 1

Arrival in Tanzania and Transfer to Arusha

Meals: Dinner | Accommodation: Arusha lodge

Arrive at Kilimanjaro International Airport and meet the Travel Hype Adventures team for your transfer to Arusha. After check-in, relax after your international flight and attend a short safari briefing covering the route, accommodation plan, luggage guidance, and practical details for your 2 week Tanzania safari.

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Day 2

Arusha National Park or Gentle Arusha Introduction

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Arusha lodge

Begin with a gentle introduction to northern Tanzania. Depending on your arrival time and energy level, visit Arusha National Park for light game viewing and scenery around Mount Meru, or enjoy a relaxed day in Arusha with optional local activities. This day helps British travellers adjust before the longer safari route begins.

Day 3

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Tarangire lodge or tented camp

Travel to Tarangire National Park, a superb first major safari destination known for elephants, baobab trees, river valleys, and open savannah. Enjoy an afternoon game drive with chances to see elephants, giraffes, zebras, wildebeest, antelopes, and predators depending on the season.

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Full Day Safari in Tarangire

Day 4

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Tarangire lodge or tented camp

Spend a full day exploring Tarangire National Park. The extra time allows your guide to cover different habitats, from riverine woodland to open plains and seasonal wetlands. This is a strong day for elephant sightings and a rewarding start to a longer Tanzania safari itinerary.

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Tarangire to Lake Manyara and Karatu

Day 5

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Karatu lodge

Continue to Lake Manyara National Park for a game drive through groundwater forest, lake-edge scenery, and escarpment landscapes. The park offers a different atmosphere from Tarangire, with opportunities for birds, monkeys, elephants, and varied vegetation before continuing to Karatu for the evening.

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Karatu to Central Serengeti

Day 6

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Central Serengeti lodge or tented camp

Travel through the Ngorongoro highlands and continue towards Serengeti National Park. The journey itself is scenic, passing highland views, open plains, and Maasai landscapes before entering one of Africa's most famous wildlife areas. Enjoy game viewing en route to your Serengeti

accommodation.

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Full Day Game Drive in Central Serengeti

Day 7

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Central Serengeti lodge or tented camp

Spend a full day in Central Serengeti, an excellent area for resident wildlife and big cat viewing. Your guide will plan the day according to wildlife movement, season, and sightings. This is one of the core reasons a 2 week Tanzania safari works so well: it gives you proper time in the Serengeti instead of rushing through it.

Day 8

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Serengeti lodge or tented camp

Continue deeper into the Serengeti ecosystem, with routing adjusted by season. Depending on travel dates, this may focus on the central plains, western corridor, northern Serengeti, or southern plains. The aim is to maximise wildlife viewing while keeping the safari comfortable and realistic for the time of year.

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Full Day Serengeti Safari

Day 9

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Serengeti lodge or tented camp

Enjoy another full day in Serengeti National Park. With more time available, your guide can follow wildlife activity at a natural pace, search for predators, explore quieter areas, and respond to seasonal movement. This longer stay helps make the package suitable for British travellers planning a premium Tanzania safari holiday.

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Day 10

Serengeti to Ngorongoro Highlands

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Ngorongoro or Karatu lodge

Take a final Serengeti game drive before travelling towards the Ngorongoro highlands. The route provides more chances for wildlife sightings while gradually shifting from endless plains to cooler highland scenery. Arrive near Ngorongoro in time to relax before the crater visit.

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Day 11 **Ngorongoro Crater Safari**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Karatu lodge

Descend into the Ngorongoro Crater for one of Tanzania's most concentrated wildlife experiences. The crater floor supports a remarkable range of animals, including lions, elephants, buffalo, zebras, wildebeest, hippos, and many bird species. It is a major highlight of a well-planned 2 week Tanzania safari.

ACCOMMODATION Karatu lodge	ACCOMMODATION —
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Day 12 **Lake Eyasi Cultural Experience**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Lake Eyasi or Karatu lodge

Travel towards Lake Eyasi for a cultural experience that adds depth to the safari. Depending on arrangements, the day may include time with local communities and insight into traditional ways of life around the lake region. This provides a meaningful contrast to the wildlife-focused days in the national parks.

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Day 13 **Lake Eyasi to Arusha via Local Villages or Coffee Country**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Arusha lodge

After breakfast, begin the journey back towards Arusha. Depending on timing and preference, stop in Karatu or Mto wa Mbu for a village visit, market walk, or coffee experience. This final full day gives the safari a relaxed ending before departure.

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Day 14 **Departure from Tanzania**

Meals: Breakfast

After breakfast, transfer to Kilimanjaro International Airport for your flight home or onward travel. You leave with a complete 2 week Tanzania safari experience covering northern Tanzania's leading wildlife areas, scenic landscapes, and cultural highlights.

Is a 2 week Tanzania safari suitable for British travellers?
