**Day 1****Arrival in Tanzania and Transfer to Arusha**

Meals: Dinner | Accommodation: Arusha lodge

Arrive at Kilimanjaro International Airport and meet the Travel Hype Adventures team for your transfer to Arusha. The first day is kept gentle so the family can rest after the long journey from the United Kingdom. Depending on arrival time, your guide will give a short briefing about the route, wildlife areas, safety guidance, and the pace of the safari.

**Day 2****Arusha to Tarangire National Park**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Tarangire lodge or tented camp

After breakfast, travel to Tarangire National Park for the first proper wildlife experience of your family safari Tanzania holiday. Tarangire is known for elephants, baobab trees, open savannah, and rewarding game viewing. The day is planned with a comfortable pace, allowing time for wildlife viewing without making the children feel over-tired on the first safari day.

**Day 3****Full Day Family Safari in Tarangire**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Tarangire lodge or tented camp

Spend a full day exploring Tarangire with your private guide. Morning and afternoon wildlife drives can be adjusted around the family's energy levels, with time to return to the lodge for a break if preferred. Look for elephants, giraffes, zebras, wildebeest, buffalo, antelopes, and predators while your guide explains the bush in a way that is engaging for both adults and younger travellers.

**Day 4****Tarangire to Lake Manyara and Karatu**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Karatu lodge

Leave Tarangire and continue to Lake Manyara National Park, a compact and scenic park that is useful for families because the game drive does not need to feel too long. The park offers forest, lake-edge scenery, baboons, monkeys, elephants, hippos, and varied birdlife. Later, continue to Karatu for dinner and overnight in the highlands near Ngorongoro.

## Day 5 **Ngorongoro Crater Safari**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Karatu lodge

After an early breakfast, descend into the Ngorongoro Crater for one of the most impressive wildlife days in Tanzania. The crater floor offers a strong chance of seeing a wide mix of animals in a dramatic natural setting, including lions, buffalo, zebras, wildebeest, hippos, and flamingos around the seasonal lakes. This is often one of the easiest big wildlife days for families because the scenery and animal viewing are concentrated in one area.

## Day 6 **Karatu to Serengeti National Park**

The journey introduces the family to the vast open plains that make the Serengeti famous. After entering the park, enjoy a game drive en route to your lodge or tented camp, with the possibility of seeing lions, giraffes, elephants, hyenas, and large plains game.
