## Overview

This Southern Tanzania safari is a 10 days / 9 nights fly-in itinerary created for British travellers who want a quieter, more remote safari experience in Tanzania. Instead of spending long hours on the road, the route uses domestic light-aircraft flights to connect Dar es Salaam with Nyerere National Park and Ruaha National Park. The journey combines river scenery, classic game drives, open wilderness, baobab landscapes and strong wildlife viewing in two of Tanzania's most rewarding southern safari destinations. Nyerere offers a distinctive safari atmosphere with the Rufiji River, boat safari opportunities and varied habitats, while Ruaha is known for its wild feel, large elephant herds, predators and dramatic scenery. This Southern Tanzania safari is well suited to guests who prefer space, authenticity and a more exclusive safari rhythm while still enjoying comfortable accommodation and well-planned logistics.

## Itinerary

### Day 1

### Arrival in Dar es Salaam

Meals: Dinner | Accommodation: Dar es Salaam hotel

Arrive in Tanzania and meet the Travel Hype Adventures team for your transfer to a hotel in Dar es Salaam. This first night gives you time to rest after your international flight from the United Kingdom and prepare for the Southern Tanzania safari ahead. Depending on your arrival time, a short briefing can be arranged to explain the fly-in route, luggage guidance for light-aircraft flights and the safari schedule.

## Day 2

### Fly from Dar es Salaam to Nyerere National Park

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Nyerere lodge or tented camp

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your scheduled light-aircraft flight to Nyerere National Park. On arrival, you are met by the lodge team and transferred into the park or reserve area, with wildlife viewing possible along the way depending on location and timing. In the afternoon, enjoy your first safari activity in southern Tanzania, introducing you to the river landscapes, woodland and open plains that make Nyerere such a rewarding destination.

## Day 3

### Safari Activities in Nyerere National Park

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Nyerere lodge or tented camp

Spend a full day exploring Nyerere National Park. The park offers a varied Southern Tanzania safari experience, with chances to see elephants, buffalo, giraffes, hippos, crocodiles, antelopes and a wide range of birdlife. Depending on lodge arrangements and conditions, the day may include wildlife drives and time near the Rufiji River system, creating a different atmosphere from a standard savannah-only safari.

## Day 4

### River Safari and Wildlife Viewing in Nyerere

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Nyerere lodge or tented camp

Continue your Nyerere safari with another day of wildlife viewing and river-focused scenery. A boat safari may be included where available, giving a close but safe view of hippos, crocodiles, waterbirds and animals coming to the river to drink. This day helps British travellers experience one of the main reasons to choose a Southern Tanzania safari: a quieter, more varied safari style with both land and water-based perspectives.

## Day 5

### Fly from Nyerere to Ruaha National Park

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Ruaha lodge or tented camp

After breakfast, transfer to the airstrip for your light-aircraft flight to Ruaha National Park. The flight keeps the journey efficient and avoids a long overland transfer between the two southern parks. On arrival in Ruaha, transfer to your lodge or tented camp and settle into one of Tanzania's most

impressive wilderness areas. An afternoon safari activity may be arranged depending on flight timing.

## Day 6

### Full Day Safari in Ruaha National Park

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Ruaha lodge or tented camp

Enjoy a full day in Ruaha National Park, a major highlight of this Southern Tanzania safari. Ruaha is known for its wild landscapes, baobab trees, seasonal rivers, elephants and predators. The park's quieter atmosphere makes it ideal for British travellers who want a more remote safari experience with fewer vehicles and a strong sense of wilderness.

## Day 7

### Ruaha Wildlife Drives and Baobab Landscapes

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Ruaha lodge or tented camp

Spend another full day exploring Ruaha's varied habitats. Wildlife drives may follow river courses, open plains and woodland areas where animals gather according to season. The combination of large mammals, birdlife, big cats and striking scenery gives this fly-in safari a strong wilderness character, especially for travellers who have already visited the northern circuit and want something different.

## Day 8

### Final Full Day in Ruaha National Park

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Ruaha lodge or tented camp

Your final full day in Ruaha allows more time to follow wildlife movements and enjoy the slower rhythm of a remote Southern Tanzania safari. Morning and afternoon safari activities provide excellent opportunities for photography, birding and general wildlife viewing. The extra time in Ruaha is important because it allows the safari to feel unhurried rather than rushed.

## Day 9

### Fly from Ruaha to Dar es Salaam

Meals: Breakfast, Dinner | Accommodation: Dar es Salaam hotel

After breakfast, transfer to the airstrip for your scheduled flight back to Dar es Salaam. On arrival, you are met and transferred to your hotel for the final night. This day creates a comfortable buffer before your international departure and helps keep the overall travel experience smoother for British guests connecting back to the United Kingdom or onward destinations.

## FAQs

### **What makes this Southern Tanzania safari different from a northern Tanzania safari?**

A Southern Tanzania safari is usually quieter, more remote and less crowded than the northern circuit. This itinerary focuses on Nyerere and Ruaha, offering river scenery, wilderness landscapes and excellent wildlife viewing with a more exclusive feel.

### **Is this a fly-in safari?**

Yes. This package uses domestic light-aircraft flights between Dar es Salaam, Nyerere National Park and Ruaha National Park, reducing long road transfers and giving more time for safari activities.

### **Is this Southern Tanzania safari suitable for British travellers?**

Yes. The itinerary is written for British travellers who want clear logistics, comfortable accommodation, reliable airport assistance and a safari route that avoids unnecessary road travel.

### **Which parks are included in this 10 day safari?**

The package includes Nyerere National Park and Ruaha National Park, with arrival and departure logistics through Dar es Salaam.

### **Can this Southern Tanzania safari be combined with Zanzibar?**

Yes. Zanzibar can be added before or after the safari for a beach extension, depending on flight schedules, available dates and preferred beach accommodation.
